Dear Parents,

In the spring, the Tennessee State Legislature passed a law that changed the high school grading scale to a ten-point scale that went into effect immediately for the 2022-2023 school year. They asked the Tennessee State Board of Education to revise elementary and middle grading scales. In September, the State Board shifted elementary and middle school to the same scale. As a result, the Sumner County School Board voted on October 18, 2022, to adopt the new grading scale for 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade. The change will be retroactive for the entire fall semester.

The new grading scale is listed below:

A	90 - 100
B	80 - 89
C	70 - 79
D	60 - 69
F	Below 60
